I agree to travel to the Championships where I am selected, as part of the England delegation and will stay with the delegation for the duration of the Championships up to and including the closing ceremony. I understand that there is a strict NO ALCOHOL policy for the duration of the stay regardless of my age.
- 2. I confirm I hold a valid British passport. A photocopy of which I will email with my entry form and this contract.
- 3. If I am selected for more than 3 events including team and/or group, I will inform the BBTSA Competition Director on the day of Selections which 3 events I wish to participate in.
- 4. I will advise the BBTSA Competition Director and Technical Director within seven days of the Selections if I do not wish to participate in the Championships in which I am selected.
- 5. Failure to take my place after this time may result in disqualification from selections the following year.
- 6. Placing at the England Selections does not guarantee Selection. The BBTSA reserve the right to refuse selection.
- 7. Your contract must be signed and returned to the BBTSA Competition Director before Selections closing date.
- 8. I agree to pay a deposit of £300 per trip to the Squad Managers at Selections. Balance to be paid before British Open.
- 9. Upon successful selection, you will be required to attend squad training sessions as advised by the Squad Managers.
